# **PROSPECTUS**

## **(SESSION 2008-09)**

The College reopens after the Summer Vacation on 17.06.08. The College is affiliated to C.H.S.E., Orissa and N.O.U., Baripada.

1. **(i) Seats & Subjects**
  - (a) **+2 Science : 192 seats**

**Compulsory :** MIL(O), English, Environmental Education, Yoga.  
**Elective :** Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology.
  - (b) **+2 Arts : 256 seats**

**Compulsory :** MIL(O), English, Environmental Education, Yoga.  
**Elective :** Pol. Sc., History, Education, Sanskrit, Economics, Logic, Oriya, Sociology.
  - (c) Students of +2 Arts & Science are asked to take 4 elective subjects. Arts students are not allowed to take Oriya with Sanskrit & Vice versa.
  - (d) New Elective subjects like Information Technology & Electronics are likely to be opened in +2 Science stream from the session 2008-09. Hence applicants are asked to keep constant touch with the college authority for the same.
  - (e) **+3 Science : 64 seats (PCM-32, CBZ-32, )**

**Compulsory :** MIL(O), English  
**Pass :** Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany, Zoology.
  - (f) **+3 Arts : 64 seats**

**Compulsory :** MIL(O), English.  
**Pass :** Pol. Science, History, Education.  
**Elective :** IP, LIH, Oriya & Sanskrit
  - (g) **Vocational Course (I.T.) (U.G.C. sponsored) - 32 seats**

Students of +3 Science are required to take two optional subjects and students of +3 Arts are required to take one optional subject and one elective subject. In addition to the normal choice of subjects, both +3 Arts and Science students may take vocational I.T. Course. Hons. in Chem, Zool., Pol. Science & Education is likely to open from the session. Hence applicants should keep constant touch with the College authority for the same.
2. Last date of receipt of application is either 15 days from the date of publication of result or reopening of the college after summer vacation, whichever is earlier.
3. Necessary forms and prospectus can be obtained from the College counter in all working days from 10 am to 1 pm either on payment of Rs. 70/- in cash or through bank draft of Rs. 90/- drawn in favour of Principal, Baripada College on any Nationalised Bank for sending forms by post.
4. **Eligibility :** Candidates who have passed H.S.C. or +2 H.S. Exam. or equivalent are eligible to apply for admission into +2 and +3 1st Year classes respectively.
5. **Selection for Admission :**
  - (a) Merit and good conduct of the applicant or any other principle as decided by the Principal will be taken into consideration for selection.
  - (b) If a selected candidate fails to get admitted on the specific date, his/her claim for admission will be forfeited. Candidates selected for admission should make themselves available on the date of admission.
6. **Reservation & Weightage :**

Reservation & Weightage will be given as per Govt. guidelines. SC-8%, ST-12%, Burma Repatriate-2%, Children of Ex-Servicemen-1%, Children of Govt. servants on transfer-4%, Oriya students living in neighbouring states who have passed H.S.C. or equivalent exam. with M.I.L(O) as a subject-5%, Orthopedically handicapped-3%. Candidates coming from such reserved categories claiming weightage should mention the same in Red Ink at the top of the application form.

7. Attested Xerox & original copies of the following documents should produced at the time of submission of form & admission respectively.
- S.L.C./ C.L.C.
  - Mark Sheet of the last qualifying examination.
  - Conduct Certificate.
  - Migration Certificate (other board)
  - Certificates in support of claim for reservation/ weightage.
  - Three copies of stamp size photographs.
  - Original money receipt (only at the time of submission of form).
8. **Accommodation :**
- Students who desire to reside in Recognized Mess / Hostel will have to mention their option clearly in the appropriate column of the application form.
  - The selection for admission to Recognized Mess / Hostel will be made according to merit after admission.

10. **Salient Features :**
- Terminal Exam. at least three times in a year excepting Half Yearly and Annual Examination.
  - Remedial coaching classes free of costs for academically weaker students in +2 and +3 stage.
  - Special care to be taken in English to clear up doubts of the students in +2 and +3 Stage.
  - Friendly and disciplined campus.
  - A compulsory computer education in +2 & +3 stage.

- N.B.:(i)** Parents are requested to admit their words in this college only when they don't have desire to take T.C. to some other college. If T.C. is taken at any time of the session one has to pay Rs.800/- as an additional amount.
- (ii) Applicants for Science & Arts should affix a postage stamp of Rs. 22/- & Rs. 5/- respectively on the intimation letter.
- (iii) Parents are requested to meet the Principal every month to assess the performance of the students.

### **INTERPRETATION OF RULES :**

The rules and regulations laid down in the prospectus are applicable for admission within the normal time for the session 2008-09.

Admission to the institution can't be claimed as a matter of right & may be refused by the Principal without assigning any reason to the candidates. In case of disputes relating to interpretation of rules & procedures here in the decision of the Principal shall be final and binding.
